

2024 Leverage Award

The Community Design Collaborative’s Leverage Award recognizes an individual whose professional or civic work has catalyzed community development and strengthened neighborhoods in Philadelphia and beyond. This year the Collaborative has the distinct privilege of honoring Prema Katari Gupta, President and CEO of the Center City District (CCD) and Executive Director of the Central Philadelphia Development Corporation.

Prema is widely considered a strategic leader in economic development, public-private real estate development, and “place-making” – the collaborative process of creating public spaces that provide people with joy and a sense of connection. She has spent the last 20 years developing her range of skills in urban design and management in Philadelphia. As the leader of the CCD, Prema currently oversees all aspects of planning, strategy, operations, and economic development efforts for the district.

“I think that downtown, any downtown, is as good as the amount of people who believe in it.” she said just last month while reflecting on her work. “It is the economic center, the place to go for arts and culture, for doctor’s appointments, healthcare, certainly for employment opportunities. And it’s the place where all this could be done without an automobile. And I think we need to move to a place where we fully realize that.”

Her work across public spaces in Philadelphia – from Dilworth Park adjacent to City Hall, to the 30th Street Station, to the Navy Yard and beyond – reflects the rare sensibility of a planning executive who has spent years studying the successes of other communities working to connect people to their towns. As a Scholar in Residence at the Urban Land Institute, she co-authored a book featuring case studies of best practices in creating town centers in 14 American cities.

“I have always been interested in human settlement patterns, which I equated with quality-of-life choices and better environments to inhabit,” she said. “People vote with their feet. If you can create a place where people like to be that is alluring, people will go there.”

A friend recently observed that Prema places a premium on even the smallest physical details involved in urban design. She has an array of pictures of trash cans and garbage collection devices, paving materials, planters, and other tangible aspects of design. She also knows to ask questions about the intangible aspects: What does it feel like to be in a place? How do people inhabit that space? What kind of services does the space provide?

“Prema is undaunted by difficult and ambiguous problems to solve,” said Matt Rader, President of the Pennsylvania Horticultural Society, and a longtime friend.


